Shared Apartments: Sandhurst House



Sandhurst House is a newly built block of apartments and is situated in a quiet street just around the corner from the Belfast school. It is an ideal location for our students, as they are only a few seconds away from the Belfast school and at the same time they are near the University District, which is full of shops, bars, restaurants, etc.

The city centre and all main bus stations and train stations are within walking distance.

The building is completely new and finished to a very high standard and consists of 1 and 2 bedroom, fully furnished apartments (including fridge, washing machine, TV, oven and dishwasher).

The one bedroom apartments are equipped with a kitchen and a dining area, 1 toilet, 1 shower room, and a lounge.

The two bedroom apartments consist of 2 private bedrooms. In this case, common areas - the toilet, kitchen and living room are shared with 1 other student. Each student will have their own shower.

If you choose a shared apartment, you will share with another student for part or for the entire duration of your stay. We will always try to match your stay with somebody who speaks a different language from you. If you come with a friend you may request to stay in the same apartment or you can request separate apartments.

Towels and sheets are provided by the school. You will receive 2 sets of sheets and 4 towels at the start of your stay which you can launder yourself and keep until the end of your stay.

The building also has wi-fi.

Note that Sandhurst House is a **non-smoking** house.

Student Residence – Queen’s Elms University Residence



The University's Halls of residence – Queen's Elms – are situated in pleasant parkland, in a quiet residential area on the south side of the city. Being on a large site, well away from the main road there is a spaciousness and calmness which generates a feeling of being far

from city life, even though Queen's Elms are less than 15 minutes walking distance from the University area.

It is also close to the Lisburn Road, which is a vibrant street, with shops, cafés and restaurants. For the fun-loving student, it is ideally located less than 20 minutes walking distance from Botanic Avenue, which is a student hotspot.

All bedrooms have full access to kitchen facilities. Each hall has a comfortable common room where students can relax. Bedrooms are serviced daily including weekends with bed linen, towels, soap, tea and coffee. On each floor visitors will find a kitchen/dining area where tea and coffee-making facilities are available. Fully-equipped laundry facilities are provided in each hall.
